IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE KEEP

Selection Criteria

We are looking for students who play brass, woodwind, percussion and string (violin, viola, cello, double bass) instruments and have a passion for music. Students should have a level of performance comparable with AMEB Grade 3 or higher. Exceptions may be made for less common or more difficult instruments.

Students must be able to read music at a reasonable level.

Audition/Interview

Short listed students will be notified and called to interview. At the interview they will audition the following:

- Two contrasting pieces (combined maximum time of 10 minutes)
- Major and minor scales up to 3 sharps (strings) and 3 flats (brass, woodwind, percussion).
- Sight reading exercise on instrument of choice or voice

Commitment to participate in school music ensembles is essential

It is expected that students will participate in the band class throughout high school – year 7 to 12 and in addition play in the school ensemble(s).

Commitment to academic studies

Copies of primary school reports for the last two years and Year 5 NAPLAN results **must** be included with your application or it may not be processed.
